

Job description – GOLF COURSE SPRAY TECHNICIAN (Full Time)

Location: Mesa Del Sol Golf Course, Yuma, AZ

Mesa Del Sol Golf Course in Yuma, Arizona is seeking a highly motivated, self-starter Golf Course Spray Technician to join our maintenance team. Mesa Del Sol Golf Course is an 18-hole, championship length public daily-fee golf course located in the Yuma Foothills.

Job Summary: Mesa Del Sol Golf Course, in the foothills of Yuma, Arizona, is seeking a licensed Spray Technician. Job responsibilities will include the application of turfgrass fertilizers and chemicals, along with the upkeep of fertilizer and chemical application documentation. Applicants should possess or have the ability to obtain a State of Arizona Certified Applicators License with the PUG designation. Individuals applying without a license must obtain a license within 30 days of employment. Other requirements of the position include daily golf course maintenance duties. Applicants will need excellent math skills, and be self-driven with a strong work ethic, a keen eye for detail and the desire to exceed expectations. Knowledge of the game of golf will be a plus.

Primary Duties & Functions:

- sprays prescribed amounts of fertilizer, insecticide, herbicide and fungicide, using hoses and truck-mounted tank or portable spray equipment
- performs routine safety inspections on all spraying equipment
- Maintains chemical storage and mixing areas in compliance with county, state and federal regulations and is responsible for the safety and direction of chemical handlers and or helpers
- Knows how to operate sprayers and spreaders
- Is able to read and interpret labels, and keeps MSDS book current
- Manages inventory and usage of applications, pesticides and fertilizers
- Maintains daily spray records and documentation;
- Assists with daily course set up, maintenance and irrigation tasks as required when spray duties are not required
- Assists with other golf course maintenance duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of the safe operation and calibration of the following types of equipment: mechanically pressurized spray equipment; hand-operated spray equipment; hand-operated rotary spreaders; hand-operated drop spreaders; utility tractors
- Current state certification or licensing as a pesticide applicator (PUG License).
- Valid driver's license required.
- Candidate must be able to work in various outdoor weather conditions
- Must be able to lift over 30 pounds horizontal, overhead, floor to waist, grasping/holding, pushing/pulling, and carrying.
