Event Descriptions

Eclectic

The Eclectic Tournament (also known as “Ringers”) is a multi-round three-month event covering all rounds played with the Ladies Club during the months of December through February. All members are automatically entered into the Eclectic tournament and the entry fee is included in membership. For this event, the best score posted on each hole by a player is added up for one final 18-hole score total for each player. Gross & Net winners announced at Spring Awards meeting.

Mesa Del Sol Cup – Match Play competition

The Mesa Del Sol Cup is a Net match play competition open to all members in good standing with established handicaps. Players are divided into 8 person flights. Players are guaranteed two matches. The overall champion is determined by playoff bracket among flight winners. Awards for overall winner and by flight. All players play from Green Tees.

Medallion

The Medallion is a 4-round stroke play competition open to all members in good standing with established handicaps. No separate entry fee is required. The four rounds that count for the Medallion are listed on the schedule. For this event, only your best 2 scores count, so you don't have to play in all 4 rounds. All players play from the Green Tees. The Gross winner and Net winner qualify to play in the state-wide AGA Medallion tournament in January of the following year (teams from all over the state participate in this event).

Club Championship

36 Hole stroke play competition open to all members in good standing with established handicaps who have played at least 5 times in Ladies Day competition on either Monday or Thursday during the current playing season. Awards for Overall & Flighted – Gross & Net. All players must play from the Green Tees.

Skins – Optional Gross & Net Skins Game on Mondays and Thursdays. Green Tee Buy-In is \$5 for Gross & Net Skins. Silver Tee Buy-In is \$3 for Net Skins only. Cash Payout.

Buy-In for Game of Day: Green Tees - \$5 – payout in Pro Shop Credit. Silver Tees - \$5 with \$3 applied to Pro Shop Credit payout for Net Game winners, and \$2 applied to Pro Shop Credit in Silver Tee player's name.
